

**“architage” 2008 Scavenger Hunt / Photography Contest Rules & Regulations  
(for Students 5 – 17 years of age)**

- 1) All participants are required to submit the Contest Entry Form with the following information completed:
  - Correct answers to 10 of the 20 clues provided
  - 3 photos of individual Doors Open sites taken during the contest period
  - Descriptions of each of the 3 photos as outlined on the form
  - Parent/Guardian signatures in the photo release and agreement to contest rules sections
- 2) Answers to each clue can be found in the site description listings pages of the Doors Open Niagara website [www.doorsopenniagara.com](http://www.doorsopenniagara.com) (go under Doors Open Niagara Weekend – click on “Canadian Sites” and “U.S. Sites”).
- 3) The contest runs from September 1 to October 19, 2008. Photos taken before or after these dates will not be accepted.
- 4) All entries are to be submitted to The Binational Tourism Alliance by 5:00 p.m., Friday, November 7, 2008. These can be delivered or mailed to either the Canadian or U.S. offices at the following addresses. All envelopes should be clearly marked “architage” Scavenger Hunt/Photography Contest, ATTENTION: Helga Honey

- 5) Entries may be color or black and white images, but must be submitted on a photo CD. Images must be a minimum resolution of 300 dpi and at least 1632 x 1224 pixels. Please do not send prints, slides or slideshows. No e-mailed images will be accepted. No allowances will be made for poor-quality images.
- 6) You must be the sole author and owner of the copyright in all photos entered. Images must not have been digitally altered in any way other than necessary burning, dodging and cropping.
- 7) Your full name, phone number, address and e-mail address must be included with each entry for the purpose of notifying you of the judges’ decision.
- 8) You must include a title for the photo (should include name of the site or building), and where and when the photo was taken (Front Door, Willowbank, Niagara-on-the-Lake, October 18, 2008). Please note that no logos, names, emblems or signage other than the name of the building itself, can be visible in submissions.
- 9) Judging will take place by December 31, 2008 and winners will be notified by January 16, 2009
- 10) A binational panel of judges who are accomplished in the field of photography will select the award winners. The judges’ decision on all matters relating to the competition is final, and no correspondence will be entered into concerning the competition’s judging and any individual or organization associated with this contest. Immediate families of the judges are not eligible to enter this contest. The identification of photo location as a Doors Open Niagara participating site will be considered to be accurate and truthful; in the event this can not be determined because of the composition of the photo, the Judging Panel reserves the right to verify that the image is of the location as stated before any prize is awarded. The Judging Panel also reserves the right to change the contest rules without prior notification.
- 11) Your photo submission is your agreement that photos can be used on the Doors Open Niagara website or placed at any gallery or on any website or in any publication without notification with proper credit to you as the photographer. The Doors Open Niagara Steering Committee also reserves the right to reproduce any winning or submitted photo, at its own expense, for the legitimate use of promoting future Doors Open Niagara events including posters that may be sold to produce revenues for the Doors Open Niagara project. All submissions become the property of the Binational Tourism Alliance. Releases: Any images including recognizable people must be accompanied by a standard photographer’s release (see Contest Entry Form), waiving rights to the image and its future use. Individual photographers retain all copyrights to their work.
- 12) For the exhibition, the photographer is responsible for the costs and preparation of their photo(s). Exact details for size and framing will be provided to all photographers invited to exhibit their works by January 16, 2009.
